> Add just the right amount of glitter to the decorations without going over the top

GLITTER & MIRRORS

Use this as a backdrop, either for your idol or for all the pretty curios in your

board (20x20 inches), orange coloured card paper, round mirrors (medium and large), tissue paper, a paper cutter, pearl-violet and golden-yellow acrylic colours, burnt sienna, metallic bronze and fine glitter gold outliners as well as a wooden placemat.

What to do

Colour your canvas board with the pearl-violet acrylic colours and leave it to dry. Fold the orange card into a triangle (multiple times) and then cut it out so that it looks like a flower with petals. Make two such flowers. Paint the wooden placemat golden yellow and let it dry. Then, arrange and stick the mirrors on it and use glitter outliners to outline the mirrors. Let it dry.

Put it together Stick some tissue rolls

on the canvas in the form of a ring, before sticking the flowers on it for a raised effect. Then stick the placemat over it. Do ensure that the petals of the upper flower are slightly curled inwards as seen in the picture. Also, decorate the corners of the canvas with mirrors.

WELL SEATED

Weave an asan for your idol by making the

best of the items you have at home.

Things you will need Recycled
newspapers, white cartridge paper, an
embossing pad, half-cut pearls, pearl
metallic gold acrylic colour, Fevicol,
fine art brushes, artistry ink in Fancy
Fuchsia and Amazon Trail colours, a flower-shaped punch and basic stationary items.

What to do

Cut a recycled newspaper into half. Roll and flatten it into a thin strip that is about one inch thick. Stick the ends together.

Repeat this process until you have 36 such strips. Weave them in an alternative manner until you have a square mat of around 18x18 (inches). Paint it pearl gold

and leave it to dry.

Next, take white cartridge papers and use a flower punch to cut out about 250 flowers. Paint them with the artistry ink in flowers. Paint them with the artistry ink in Fancy Fuchsia and Amazon Trail shades. Arrange and stick the flowers in layers, so that the pink flower is the upper layer and the green is the lower layer. Stick half cut pearls in the centre of each flower. Put It together Arrange and stick the flowers on the golden mat.

THE FAN GAME

Place your idol over it — this will help you get the best possible bird's-eye shots of it!

s you will need Dark green, red and yellow tinted papers, a pencil, a pair of scissors, quilling tool, glitter gold outliner and Fevicol.

What to do

Fold a sheet of dark green tinted paper, using the fan folding technique so that when you look at it from a side angle, it resembles a range of hills. Do the same with five more sheets. Stick them all end to end, so that it takes the shape of a

round fan, as seen in the image. Cut the red and yellow card papers into circles (13 red coloured ones and 10 yellow coloured ones), each with a radius of 14 inches. Then, cut each one spirally from the outer circumference to the from the outer circumference to the centre of the circle and quill the spiral cut outs with a quilling tool. Stick the ends of each flower together with Fevicol.

Put it together Arrange and stick the red and yellow flowers on the dark green round shaped fan that you made earlier. Enhance the edges of the flowers by dabbing at them with an outliner. Voila! You have a unique seat for your Ganesha.
