We wish to inform you that the Company has received an order dated $2^{\text {nd }}$ February, 2024, which was received on $12^{\text {th }}$ February, 2024 through post, from the Office of the Commissioner of Customs (NS-II), Nhava-Sheva, Jawaharlal Nehru Customs House imposing a fine of Rs. 5,00,000/- and penalty of Rs. 32,50,537/- under applicable provisions of the Customs Act, 1962.

The Customs department has passed an order for the levy of fine and penalty under Section 125(1) and Section 114A of the Customs Act, 1962 towards the levy of Anti Dumping Duty on certain import of goods. Against this order, the Company intends to file for legal remedy by way of an appeal.

Based on the Company's assessment, the Company reasonably expects a favorable outcome at the appellate level. There is no material impact on the financials, operations or other activities of the Company.
